

Title : The Canopi Resort opens in Treasure Bay Bintan Phase 1

The Canopi Resort opens in Treasure Bay Bintan development

The opening of The Canopi Resort in October marks the progress in phase one of Treasure Bay Bintan, a 338-hectare waterfront resort development in the north of the Indonesian island, just 10 minutes' drive from the ferry terminal.

Canopi has 40 tent-suites facing the 6.3-hectare Crystal Lagoon, Southeast Asia's first and largest recreational body of filtered sea-water. Canopi's 'glamping' concept features three types of air-conditioned tents—some with an outdoor jacuzzi—and all having king-size and sofa beds, with semi-open-air bathrooms.

Developed by Landmarks Berhad, Treasure Bay Bintan will take shape over 10 to 20 years. Other projects such as Chill Cove, Canyon Ranch Bintan, an eastern wellness spa-resort, and the Mercure Bintan Resort, will enhance the island's destination appeal.

"This development brings a new and different perspective to Bintan island with its unique and innovative concepts," says Stefan Thumiger, Treasure Bay Bintan chief operating officer. "We want to dispel the image that nothing has changed in recent years."
